



TEHACHAPI SOCIETY OF PILOTS FLYING SCHOLARSHIP

In 2019 the TSP will be awarding up to two scholarships for flying training, with a total value up to \$5,000.

The two categories are:

1. Initial Flying Training. This scholarship is for someone who has no previous flying training that would like to work towards a Private Pilot License. Requirements for this scholarship are:
 - a. Be 16-21 years old at time of application
 - b. Be able to meet the medical requirements of a student pilot license
 - c. Have a demonstrated interest in aviation
 - d. Have sound grades in school
 - e. Reside in Tehachapi or the surrounding district
2. Advanced Rating. This scholarship category is to assist a pilot who wishes to add an advanced rating such as Commercial, CFI, or Instrument to their existing license. Requirements for this scholarship are:
 - a. Hold a Private Pilot License
 - b. Have already started ground or flying training for the advanced rating
 - c. Reside in Tehachapi or the surrounding district

To apply for either scholarship clearly address the 10 points listed below in one page, up to 500 words.

1. Scholarship you are applying for (Initial Flying Training or Advanced Rating).
2. Name.

5. Email address.
6. Age.
7. What are your recent academic grades?
8. What is your flying experience?
9. Are you currently receiving financial assistance for flying training?
10. Describe your interest in aviation. What activities have you participated in to further this interest?

Note: Scholarship money will be paid directly to the aircraft provider and flight instructor. Scholarship winners will be required to contribute \$20 per flight hour towards the total cost of aircraft rental
